CHRISTMAS SURPRISES — Seedipalem

Seedipalem: This is an interior village area. This is not accessible so easily. Vehicle cannot reach this place. The water is not drinkable as it contains a lot of calcium, and florid elements. Many local people are born blind and disabled. They are affected with tuberculosis, malaria, typhoid, cholera, etc. Our international director Pastor Bro.Allan Rich .France visited this area in 2009

March and prayed for the people. One of the women and two children were cured of tuberculosis, malaria when Bro. Allan prayed. During this Christmas she gave a witness and many people were happy with her cure. And now they are expecting another visit of Bro.Allan Rich. The woman who was cured, is going for work now. The Christmas celebration ended with a peaceful worship service. Our director Baviri distributed 25 sarees to the poor women. Food was also served to the villagers. Bro.Baviri gave the Christmas

message. Pastor Melchisadek and pastor B. Jeevaratnam conducted the service.
